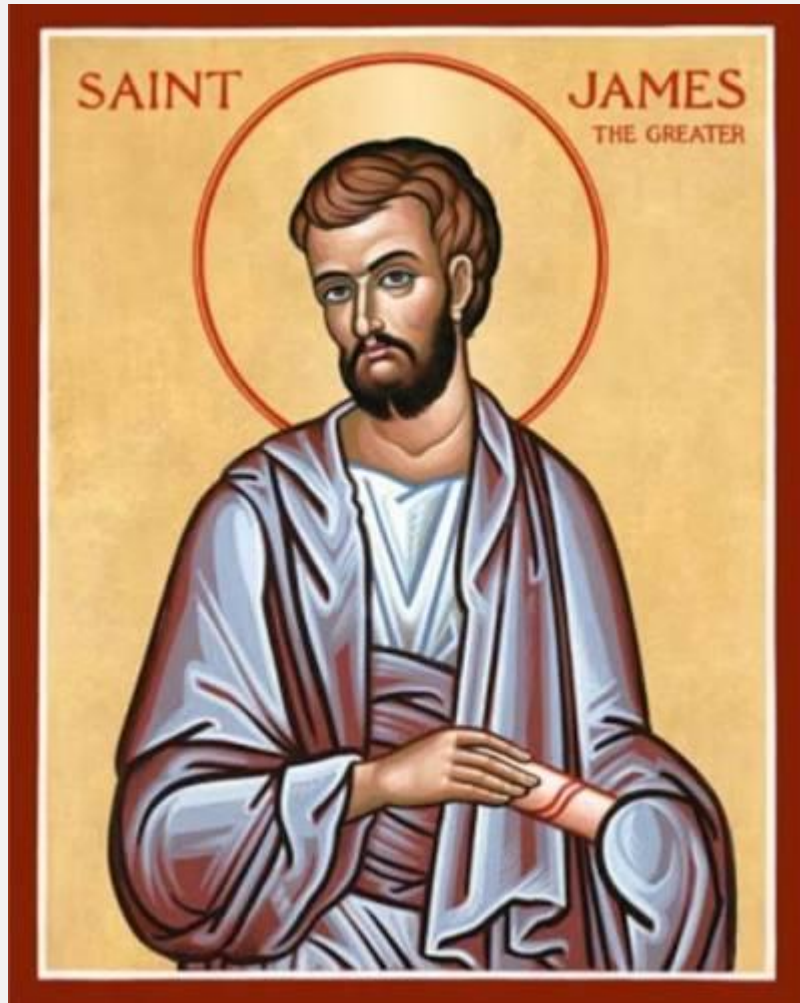

THE SERMON

THE NICENE CREED

BCP, 104

We believe in one God, the Father, the Almighty, maker of heaven and earth, of all that is seen or unseen. 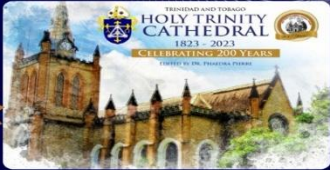

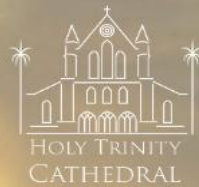
