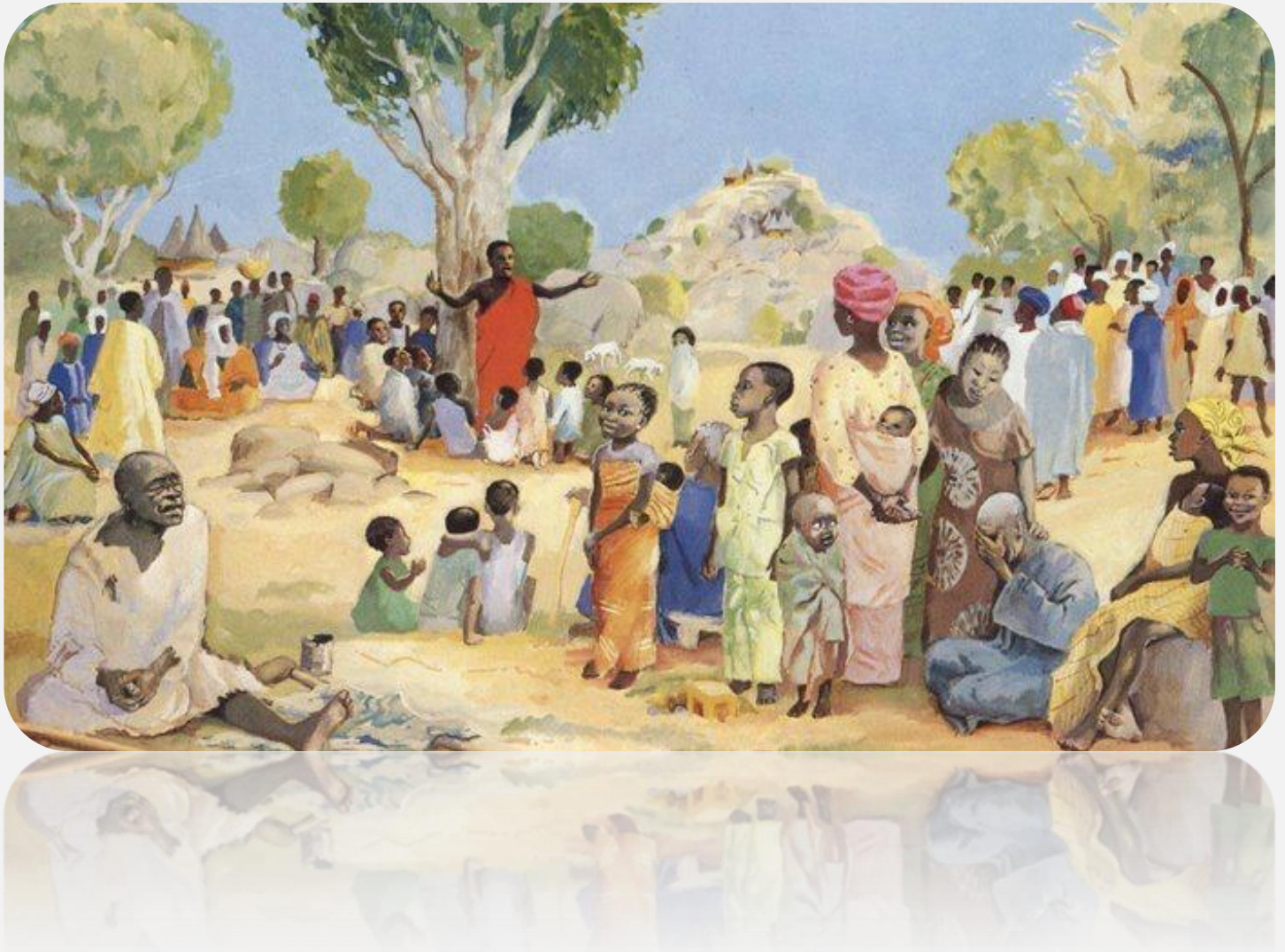

THE SERMON

THE NICENE CREED
